There will also be a display in tribute to Border Patrol and other sworn officers who have fallen to to foreign invasion on the southern borders of California and Arizona.

This event will be open to associates and associated groups. If your group/organization would like to host the event for an hour or two during the day, you may display your banner and distribute your material during that time.

For those who cannot attend, we will stream video and pictures to the SaveOurState.info website and as a back-up, to the FightBackinSac.com website throughout the day for you to send to your friends and neighbors, or anyone you see fit in the State of Arizona to advise and notify them that they are not alone and that they have California's support.

Our flags and table will be set up on California's State Capitol grounds, on the northern side close to the sidewalks that lead to the Capitol entrance. We will pass out literature, display information, and speak to our fellow citizens about illegal immigration, border security, sovereignty, and security of American Citizens

We will also condemn "One Bill" Gil Cedillo's effort to speak for all Californians on the Arizona SB1070 issue. The California Latino Legislative Caucus cannot be allowed to speak on behalf of all Californian's.
