1 FACTS:

3 NOTIFICATION: I was dispatched to a call of a non-injury collision at 0234 hours. I
4 responded from San Juan and Greenback and arrived on scene at 0238 hours. All times, speeds
5 and measurements in this investigation are approximate. Measurements were taken by
6 estimation, except where otherwise indicated.

8 SCENE: At the scene of this collision, Madison Ave is an eastbound/westbound city street
9 consisting of 3 lanes. The roadway is straight and level. The surface is composed primarily of
10 asphalt. Madison Ave is intersected by Highview Ln. Highview Ln is a northbound/southbound
11 residential roadway consisting of 2 lanes. The roadway is straight and level. The surface is
12 composed primarily of asphalt. The intersection is no controls. See diagram.

16 Party #1 (Lopez) was located on scene. Party 1 was identified by a foreign national ID card.
